

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS (Terms and Conditions)

WHO ARE THE MUSICIANS BARNEYS' BAZAAR IS LOOKING FOR?

Barneys' Bazaar is primarily to strengthen community and develop trust in neighbourhoods around the north-west of Adelaide. Therefore, the musicians we are looking for are those that engage proactively with people and thrive on personal interactions. We want musicians that express themselves in a considerate and respectful way. Bands or solo performers are eligible.

WHAT MUSIC CAN BE PERFORMED?

Your own music can be performed or covers. You are welcome to introduce the music you will be performing. The style of music is primarily music that is more background music to the Bazaar. We do not want music that is overpowering but gentle music that is calming and assists with a warm atmosphere. You can perform for a minimum of 30 minutes up to an hour.

SETTING UP

Signage can be set up, but only blue tac may be used to affix signs to walls, etc. **NO TAPE** allowed. Signage must be **contained** within your performance area and must not impinge on the walkways and thoroughfares.

WHEN CAN I SET-UP?

You can set-up between 15-30 minutes before your performance.

WHERE WILL THE MUSICIANS BE PERFORMING?

You will either be performing in the hall on a stage or in the main building in the middle of the room.

CAN I CANCEL BEING A MUSICIAN?

If circumstances change after being accepted as one of the musicians and you cannot attend the Bazaar, you will need to notify the Bazaar coordinator.

APPLICATIONS

Applications will be assessed for Barneys' Bazaar based on their originality, how much information has been supplied and the uniqueness of the of what the musician can offer.

HOW MANY STALLHOLDERS/FOOD TRUCKS WILL THERE BE?

40 stallholders are the limit for each Barneys' Bazaar in 2019 and 8 food trucks.

RENUMERATION

Some form of remuneration for your time to perform will be negotiated with the Bazaar coordinator.
